ECG Rule of Fours • LITFL

- Difficult to interpret ECG
- Right or Left
- Normal P wave
- Followed by a T wave. Abnormalities: right bundle branch blocks
- Indicates conduction problems in the right side of the heartthe heart
- May be normal in healthy people
- R wave in V1, ie two R waves in Vin V1
