Nine Basic Ways to Improve Your Style in Academic Writing 1. Use ACTIVE VOICE. Don't say: "The stepmother's house was cleaned by Cinderella." (Passive.) Say instead: "Cinderella cleaned the stepmother's house." (Active voice.) Passive voice construction ("was cleaned") is reserved for those

occasions where the "do-er" of the action is unknown.

Make your point and move on. (You won't be more persuasive by stating it over and over.) Similarly, don't overload your essay with quoted passages illustrating multiple examples of an idea. Remember that your purpose is not, as with generic essay-writing, to show your teacher that you have done your homework.
