The combined oral surgery and orthodontic treatment options for unerupted teeth are threefold: extraction, exposure ± orthodontics and autotransplantation (most frequently of canines). In some cases (e.g. mesiodens when no orthodontics is planned) unerupted teeth may be left in situ.

Combined orthognathic surgery and orthodontic therapy is a well established treatment modality for the correction of moderate to severe dentofacial deformities. 1 The surgery primarily aims to correct the skeletal discrepancy so as to facilitate further orthodontic therapy to correct the residual malocclusion.

Orthognathic surgery (/ ˌ ɔː θ ə ɡ ˈ n æ θ ɪ k /); also known as corrective jaw surgery or simply jaw surgery, is surgery designed to correct conditions of the jaw and face related to structure, growth, sleep apnea, TMJ disorders, malocclusion problems owing to skeletal disharmonies, or other orthodontic problems that cannot be easily treated with braces.

Orthodontic Treatment Objectives • Undesirable angulation of the anterior teeth occurs as a compensatory response to a developing dentofacial deformity. • For example, a patient with maxillary deficiency, mandibular excess, or both often has dental compensation for the skeletal abnormality with flared upper incisors and retracted or retroclined lower incisors (Fig. 26.8A-C).
