As not every rural area can sustain every service, other services that should be reasonably accessible through multiple delivery methods include mental health, substance abuse treatment, oral health, emergent/urgent care, surgery and obstetrics, pharmacy, eye care and audiology, public health, education and cultural competency, inpatient acute care, outpatient care, in-home care and monitoring, long-term institutional care, and transportation services.
