SOUTHERN RED OAK-Southern red oak is one of Tennessee's most common trees. It usually has a round, well pruned trunk with a slight swell at the base and good form up to strong, well spaced limbs at the top. The bark is very rough but thin (less than 3/8" thick) giving the illusion of its being compressed and glued to the tree.
