After the war he was mistakenly imprisoned as a deserter and began writing what would become The Cretan Runner (published in English in 1955 and in Greek in 1986) while in prison. In addition to his memoir, Psychoundakis wrote The Eagle's Nest , a study of the customs of Cretan mountain dwellers, and translated works by Hesiod and Homer into the Cretan language.
