In a musical composition, tempo is usually described with Italian words such as *largo*, *adagio*, *allegro*, etc. Rhythm: In songs, words usually match the rhythm. The origin of the word is Greek, meaning "flow." As meter pulsates a poem, rhythm organizes music in much the same way.
