Caring for Orchids. A west or lightly shaded south window is best for growing most orchids. As a general guideline you can water your orchids with a thorough soaking once a week. Keep the humidity high by misting your plants once a day or put them on orchid growing humidity trays. Most Orchid plants will grow well in the temperatures of your home, but they do prefer to cool down at night to 55 - 60 degrees and they do need a period of darkness, so don't leave any nearby lights on at night.
